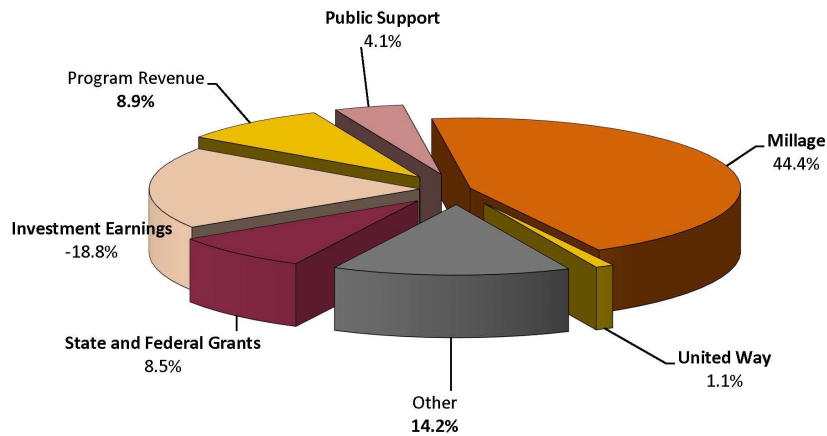




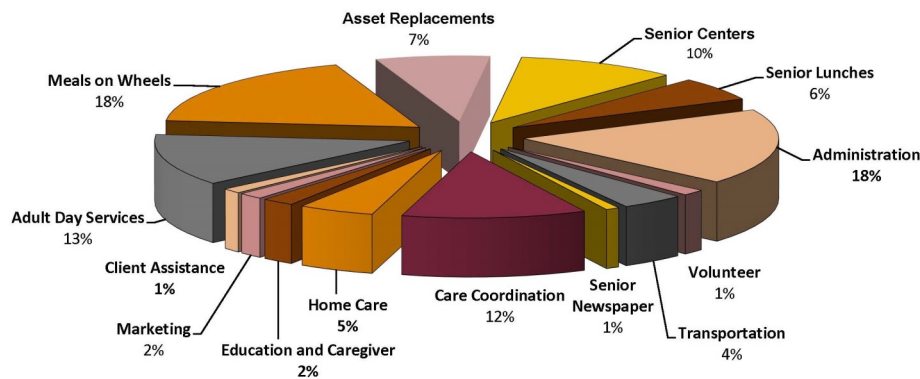

Serving Our Community



Adult Day Services

Seasons served **99** participants for a total of **25,473** service hours.



Assessment & Coordination of Services

Care Coordination assisted **1,784** clients, totaling **9,572** service hours.



Caregiver Support Group & Classes

77 people participated in caregiver programs, providing over **281.75** service hours.



Counseling

Senior Services and our partner, Family and Children's Services, provided **1,196** counseling hours to **85** clients.



Handyman Services

Volunteer handymen completed **371** separate health and safety tasks helping **339** older adults.



Health Benefits Assistance

265 individuals were assisted with their health care and prescription coverage options. Health Benefits Hotline received **430** callers.



Home Care Services

210 seniors received **7,633** hours of home care service.



Meals on Wheels

167 volunteers delivered **155,281** meals to **868** seniors.



Transportation **378** clients were transported on **11,265** one-way trips.
